SECURITY COUNCIL MANDATE

The UN Security Council is responsible for maintaining international peace and security (UN Charter, Art. 24) in accordance with the principles and purposes of the United Nations, including:

-  Saving succeeding generations from the scourge of war (UN Charter, Preamble)
-  Promoting social progress and freedom (UN Charter, Preamble)
-  Affirming the equal rights of men and women and of nations large and small (UN Charter, Preamble)
-  Ensuring the least diversion of resources for armaments (UN Charter, Art. 26)
